in the earth about us, we give You honor and glory.**

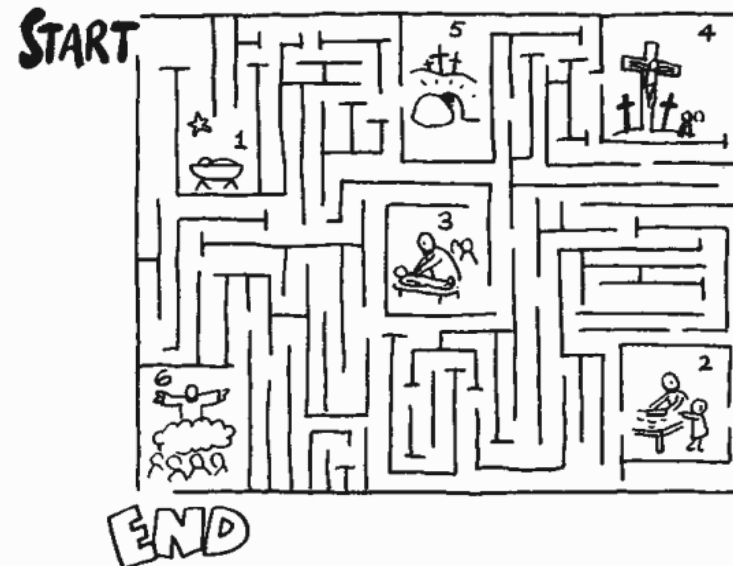
**For the sun and rain, for the manifold fruits of our fields,
